- Parents are required to provide a certified baptismal certificate, if your child was **not** baptized at Prince of Peace or St. Mary of the Woods Chapel.
We can make a copy of your child's original Baptismal Certificate.
Otherwise, you will need to contact the parish office, where your child's baptism took place, and request a copy be faxed to Prince of Peace Parish at 231 744-4859 or emailed at hchampoux@princeofpeacenm.org

Reconciliation Requirements:

- 1) Parents must complete and return a **Sacrament Registration form** to Holly Champoux at hchampoux@princeofpeacenm.org
- 2) Parents must provide a **Certified Baptismal Certificate** or specify when your Child's Baptism was held at Prince of Peace Parish
- 3) Your child must be enrolled and attend a **CGS Level II atrium session on a weekly basis**
- 4) Parent and child must complete Together in Jesus First Reconciliation lessons
- 5) One parent must accompany their child to the Sacrament Retreat on Saturday March 18, 2023 9:30am – Noon

First Eucharist Requirements:

- 1) Your child continues to attend a **CGS Level II atrium session on a weekly basis**
- 2) Prince of Peace must receive a Certified copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate
- 3) Parents must ensure your child received the Sacrament of Reconciliation
- 4) Parent and child complete Together in Jesus First Eucharist lessons.
- 5) Parents and child attends Eucharist retreat on Saturday April 22, 2023 9:30am-Noon.
